



1st TEACHER JESUS

directions on back

YOU'LL NEED

- Teacher picture (1 per room)
- Jesus head (1 per room)

2nd SAY WITH ME

all ages

Say Together: Jesus is my teacher!

3rd QUESTIONS

ages 4-K

- Tell me your teachers' names. Answers will vary.
 If kids are not in daycare or school yet, help them say the names of the leaders in the room.
- 2. Who is the best teacher? Jesus



Say: I had some really fun teachers when I was a kid. I learned a lot from them!

1. **Show** the teacher picture.

Say: This picture reminds me of all my old teachers. But it also reminds me of someone else! Someone who is the *best* teacher, ever! Who do you think He is?

2. Kids guess.

Say: If you said Jesus, you're right! Jesus is the best teacher. We can learn from Him and obey Him all the time! Now, let's turn this teacher into Jesus!

- 3. **Choose** a kid to put the Jesus head on the teacher picture.
- 4. When the kid puts Jesus' head on the teacher picture everyone says, "Jesus is my teacher!"
- 5. **Repeat** steps 3-4 to give as many kids as possible a turn.

Say: When we learn from the Bible, we can learn from Jesus! He's the best teacher because He teaches us God's way!

- 6. Say "Say With Me" listed on the front.
- 7. For ages 4-K, **ask** "Questions" listed on the front.







1st IN THE BIBLE

YOU'LL NEED

- Storybook Bible (1 per room)
- Look in the Bible activity supplement (1 per room)

2nd SAY WITH ME

all ages

Say Together: Jesus is my teacher!

3rd QUESTIONS

ages 4-K

- What book can help us learn from Jesus? The Bible
- 2. What are some things Jesus teaches us in the Bible? Answers will vary. See Look in the Bible activity supplement for ideas if needed.



Before Prop Talk

1. **Place** Look in the Bible activity supplement inside the Storybook Bible.

Prop Talk

1. Show the Bible.

Say: Friends, look! I have a Bible.

Lead kids through this Bible poem: "The Bible is God's book for you! You can trust it's right and true."

Say: We can look in the Bible to learn how to live God's way. That's how Jesus teaches us! Let's learn together right now!

- 3. **Read** the first verse from the Bible activity supplement as if you're reading directly from the Bible.
- 4. **Demonstrate** the motion listed after the verse, and **help** kids **do** the motion together.
- 5. **Repeat** steps 3-4 for the rest of the verses on the activity supplement.
- 6. Say "Say With Me" listed on the front.
- 7. For ages 4-K, **ask** "Questions" listed on the front.





THE KING AND THE KINGDOM

1st ROCK OR SAND

directions on back

YOU'LL NEED

- Rock (1 per room)
- Bag of sand (1 per room)

2nd SAY WITH ME

all ages

Say Together: Jesus is my teacher!

3rd QUESTIONS

ages 4-K

- 1. What choices make you strong like a house on a rock? Answers will vary. See Strong or Weak List on back for ideas if needed.
- 2. What choices make you weak like a house on soft and shifting sand? Answers will vary. See Strong or Weak List on back for ideas if needed.

ROCK OR SAND directions

- Choose two kids to stand in front of the small groups with you.
- 2. **Give** one kid the rock, and one kid the sand.

Say: I'll tell you some choices. You tell me if it's a strong choice like building a house on a rock ...

3. **Tell** kid with the rock to **hold up** the rock.

Say: ... or if it's a weak choice like building a house on soft and shifting sand.

4. Kid with the sand **holds up** the sand, and **wiggles** it to show how shifting it is.

Say: Okay, here's the first choice!

- Read a choice from the Strong or Weak List below.
- 6. If it's a strong choice, kids **say**, "Strong!" and kid with rock **holds up** the rock.
- 7. If it's a weak choice, kids say, "Weak!" and kid with sand holds up the sand.
- 8. **Repeat** steps 5-7 for all of the choices on the list, **choosing** as many kids to have turns with the rock and the sand as you can.
- 9. Say "Say With Me" listed on the front.
- 10. For ages 4-K, **ask** "Questions" listed on the front.

Strong or Weak List

Strong

- Obey my leaders
- Learn from the Bible Run when I should
- Pray for people
- Help people

Weak

- Disobey leaders
- Run when I should walk
- Laugh when people get hurt
- Never share





THE KING AND THE KINGDOM

1st STRONG LIFE

directions on back

YOU'LL NEED

• Wooden blocks (10 per room)

2nd SAY WITH ME

all ages

Say Together: Jesus is my teacher!

3rd QUESTIONS

ages 4-K

- 1. Who can you obey to build a strong life? Jesus
- 2. How can you build a strong life on Jesus? Obey what Jesus teaches.

STRONG LIFE

1. Place blocks in a pile next to you.

Say: Friends! Look at all these blocks I have! Blocks remind me I can build my life on Jesus when I obey what Jesus teaches.

2. Place a block on the ground.

Say: I can build my life on Jesus when I'm kind to my friends, even when they're mean to me.

- 3. **Stack** a block on top of the first block while you talk about being kind.
- Choose a kid to stack another block on the tower as you say another way you can build your life on Jesus. See Strong Life list below for ideas.
- 5. Repeat step 4 until all the blocks are stacked.

Note: If your kids are younger, you may want to make two stacks of five blocks each instead of attempting one tall stack of ten blocks.

Say: Wow! There are lots of good ways we can build our lives on Jesus. We can obey God and show others we believe in Him!

- 6. Say "Say With Me" listed on the front.
- 7. For ages 4-K, **ask** "Questions" listed on the front.
