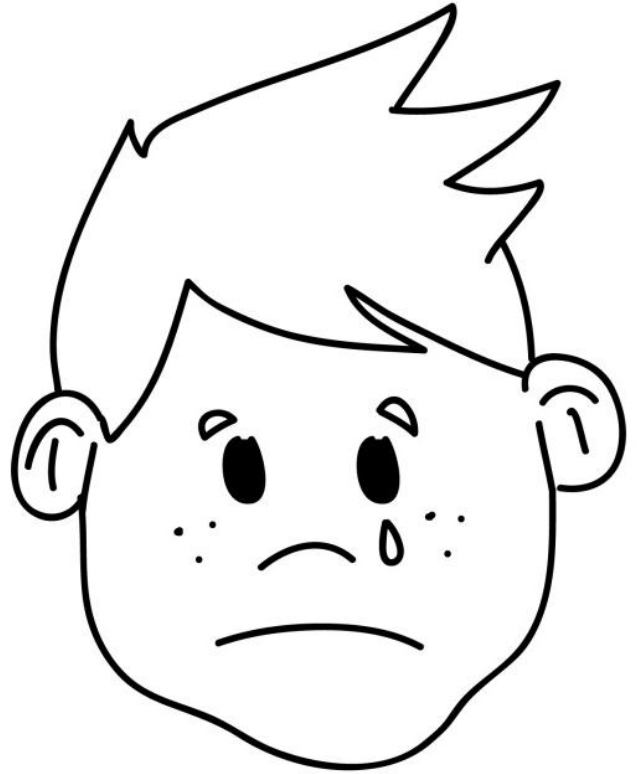




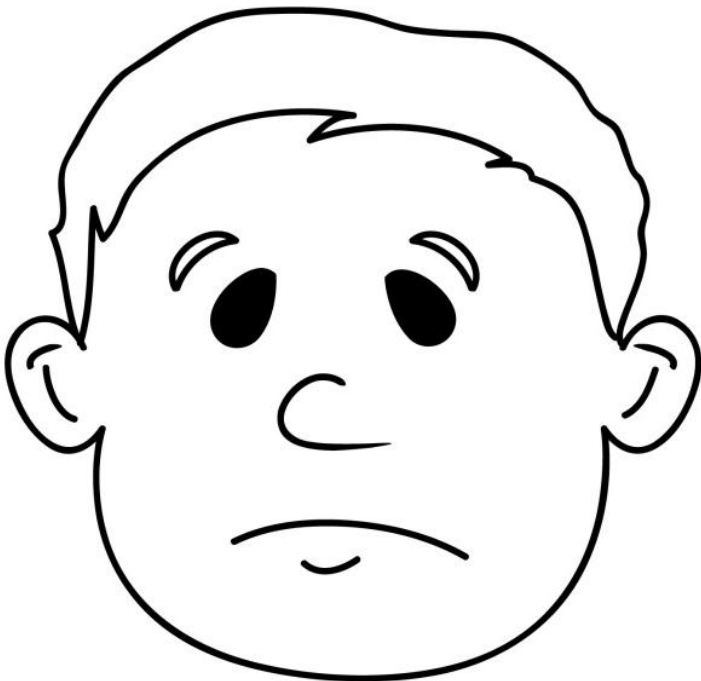


*Jada's sister jerked a toy out of her hands. Should Jada jerk it back or forgive her sister like Joseph?
Let's say this with Jada, "I forgive you sister."*



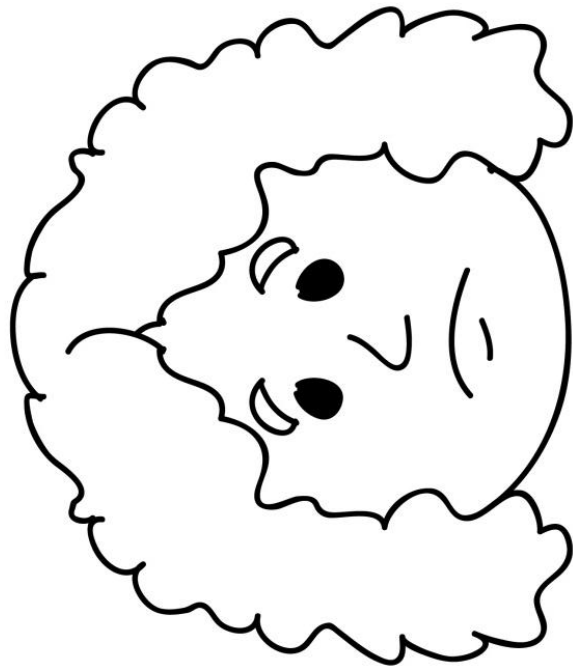
Stephan's best friend just yelled at him. Should Stephan yell back at his friend or forgive him?

Nicolas was playing with his friend when his friend pushed him down. Should Nicolas push his friend down, too, or be like Joseph & forgive?

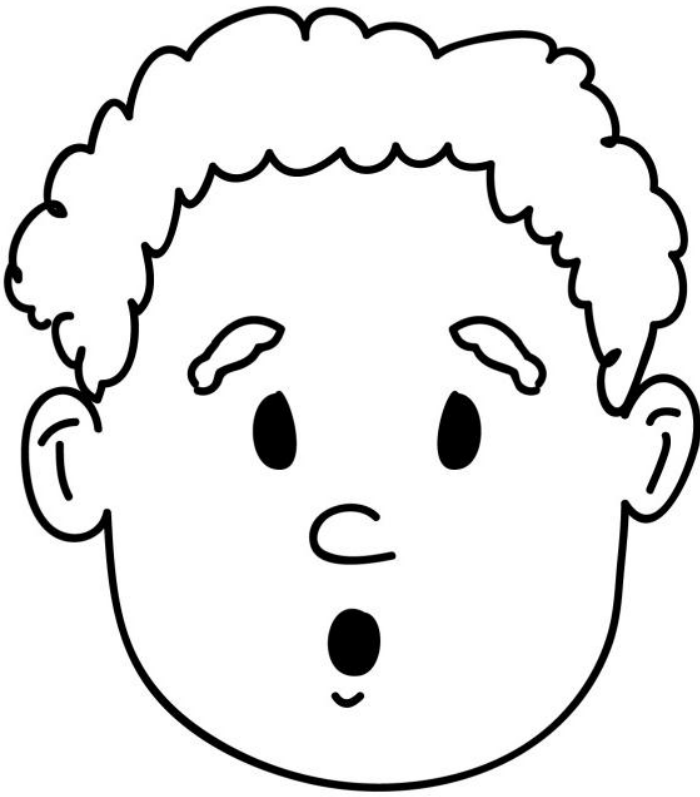
Let's say this with Nicolas, "I forgive you friend."

Let's say this with Jamie, "I forgive you mommy."





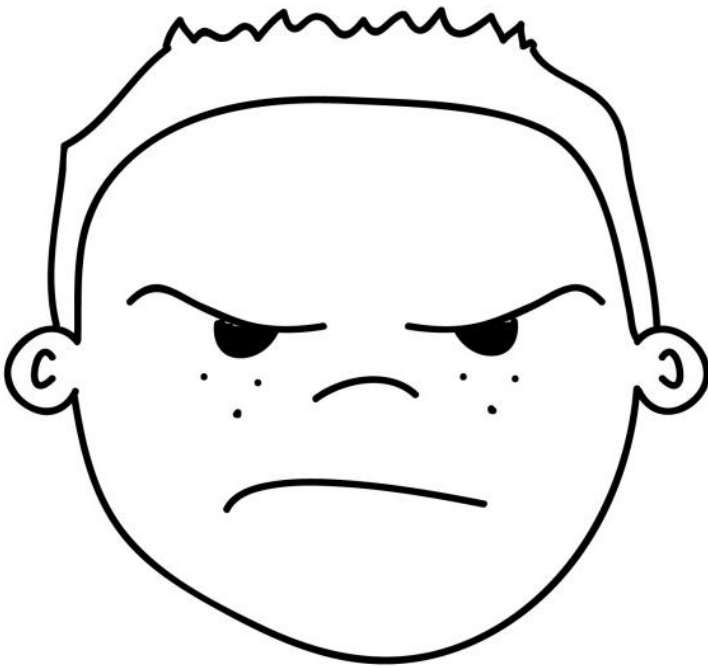
Christian just saw his little brother knock down the blocks he had been building all day. What should Christian do? (Forgive & rebuild)

Ben is watching his favorite show on TV when his older sister changes the channel. Should Ben run to tell on his sister or forgive her and wait patiently for his turn?

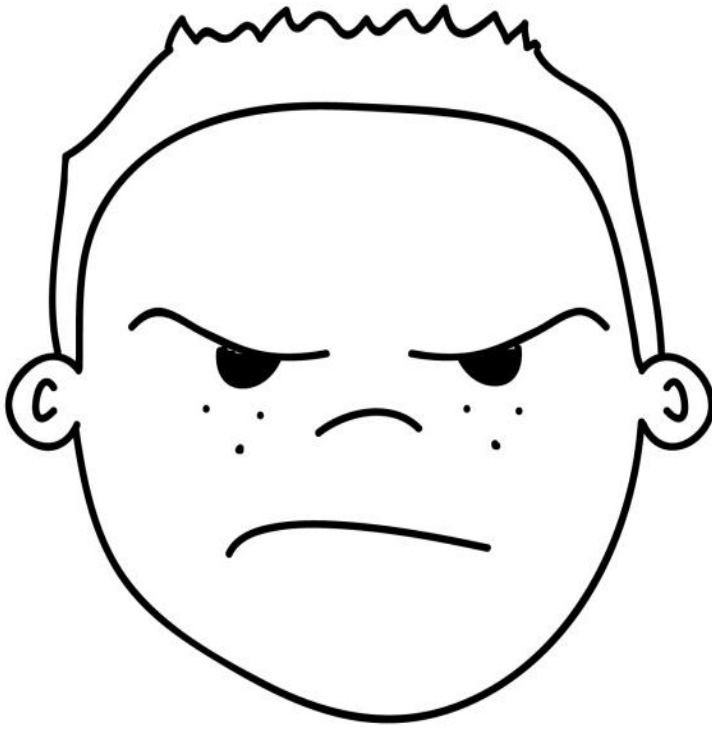
Let's say this with Ben, "I forgive you sister."

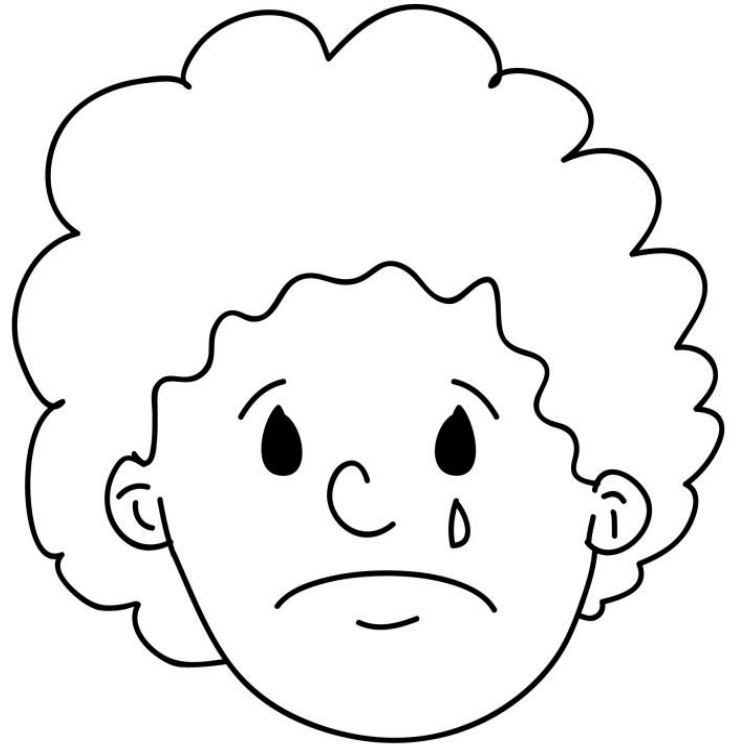
Let's say this with Hannah, "I forgive you."





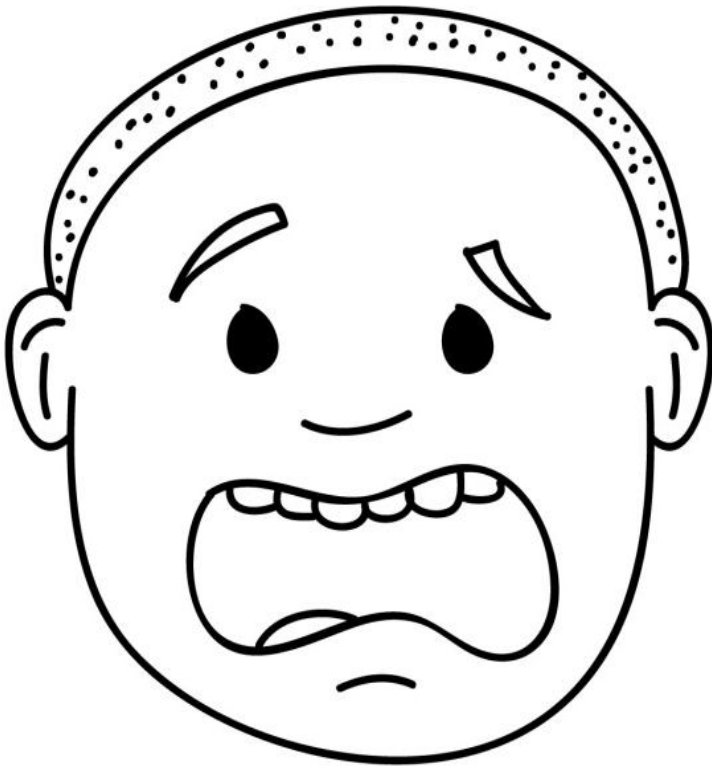

Let's say this with Luke, "I forgive you."



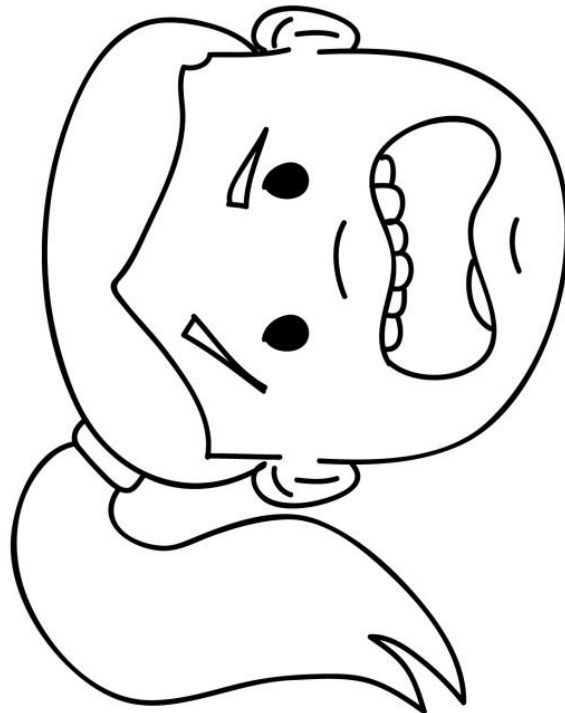
