Exodus 1 - 2:20

(Point to Pharaoh) ***This is King Pharaoh.***

(Make a mean face)

***Pharaoh was being very mean to
God's people.***

***He wanted to hurt the baby boys.
Can you pretend to rock a baby?***

(Pretend to rock a baby)



(Point to mommy)

***One mommy tucked her baby in a basket and
put him in the water to keep him safe.***



(Point to princess)

Pharaoh's daughter was the princess.

She found the baby floating in the water.

***She picked him up and named him
Moses.***

Can you say "Moses"?



(Point to sister) ***The baby's big sister was watching him float. The big sister was named Miriam. Can you say "Miriam"?***

***Miriam saw the princess pick up her baby brother!
She ran to tell the princess she could help. Then she ran
to get her mommy!***



Miriam is a hero because she helped her family! YOU can be a hero like Miriam if YOU help your family! Say this with me (kids repeat each line after you):

I Can (thumbs to chest)

Be A Hero (fists on hips)

Like Miriam! (rock baby)
