**If Maddox wants to be a hero, what should he do?**

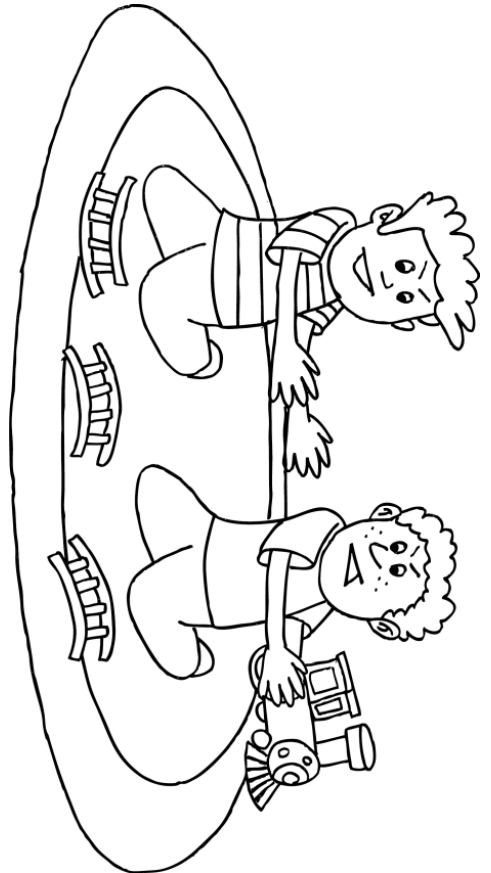
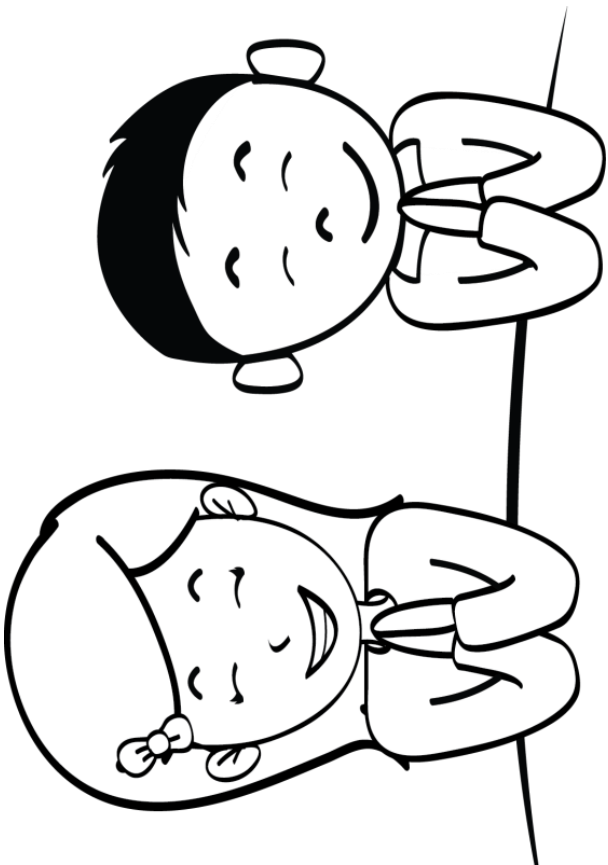
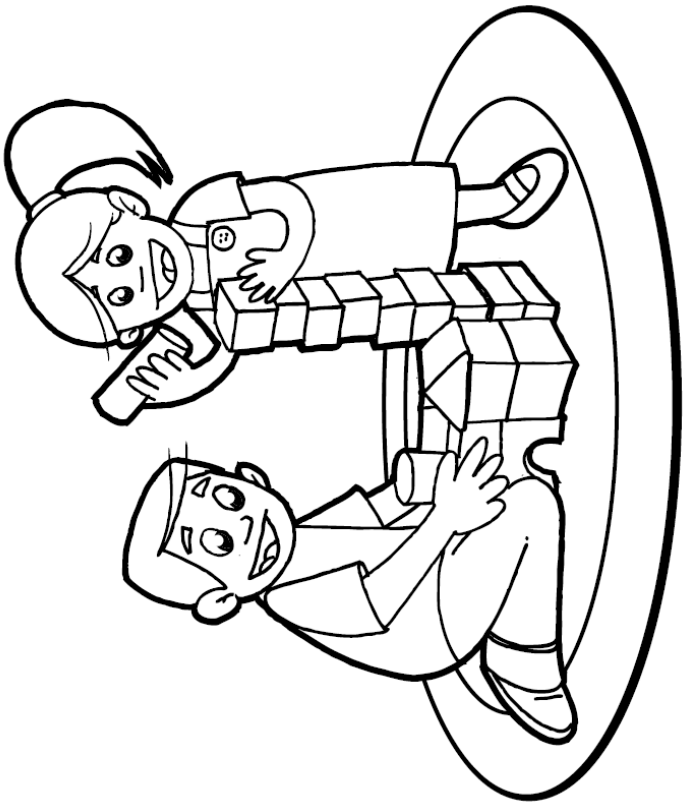
**Maddox can be a hero by not giving up! He can put on his swimmyies and learn how to swim!**

**No, that would be bad.**

**If Miguel wants to be a hero, what should he do?**  
(Don't give up on being kind, even though his cousin is being mean)

**Somebody keeps taking the toys Bryson is playing with, so Bryson keeps finding new toys to play with.**

**Is Bryson being a hero? (Yes)**

**Bryson is being a hero because he's not giving up on being kind, even when others are not!**

**You can be a hero by never giving up, too!**

**If Jack and Jill do not give up on praying, are they being heroes? (Yes)**

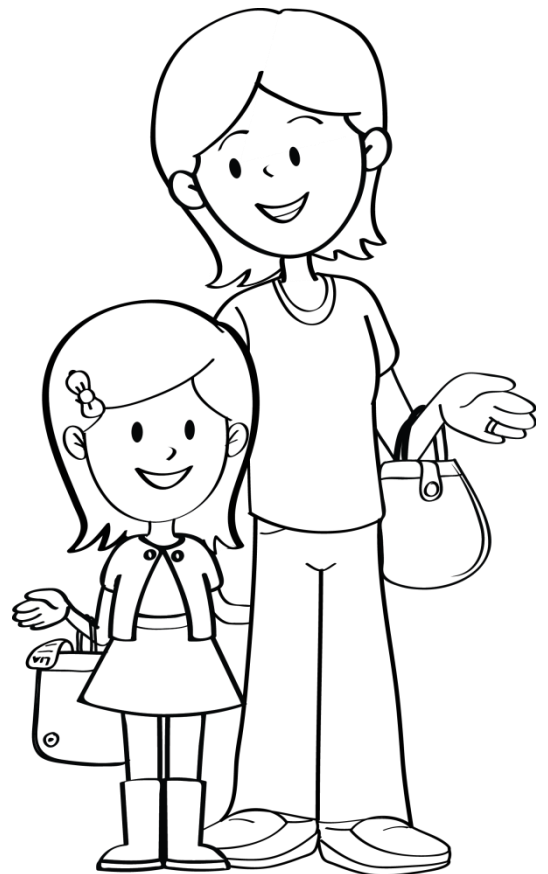
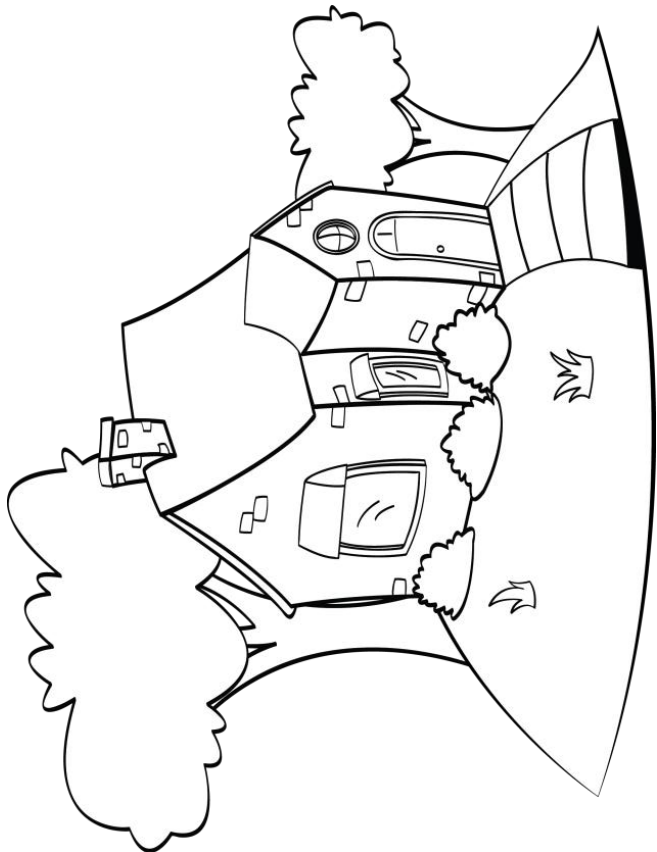
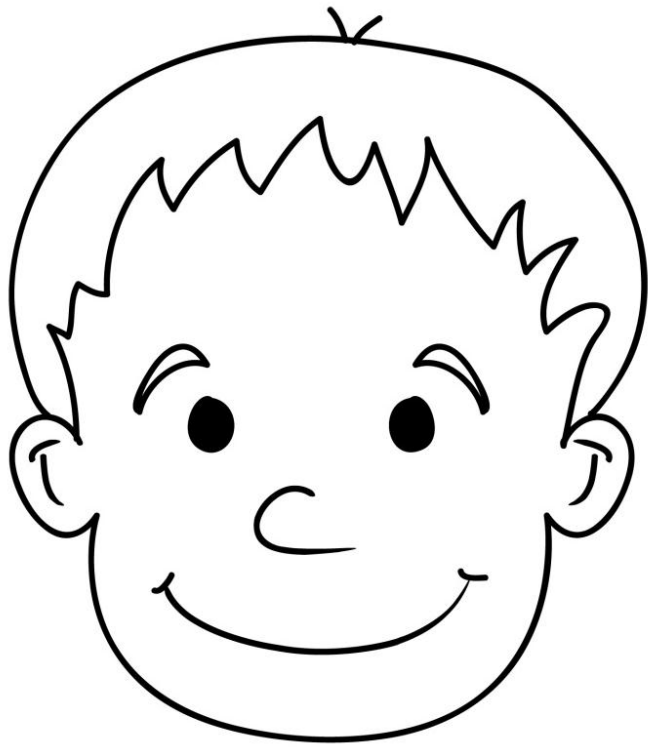
**Yes! Jack and Jill should keep praying!**

**Sam has been playing in his room and there are toys everywhere!**

**His dad asked him to clean up the toys, but he's tired of doing it. He wants to give up!**

**What should we heroes tell Sam to do? (Never give up, ask for help)**

**That's right!**

**Maggie has been shopping with her mom all day.**

**Maggie was happy at first, but now she is tired of shopping**

**Should Maggie give up on being happy and start whining? (No)**

**No! Maggie can be a hero by never giving up!**

**Let's all say this together:**
