



## David and Jonathan

1 Samuel 16:15-23; 18:1-4; 19:1-7

(Point to David, playing the harp) ***This is David.***

***David lived in the king's house. Anytime King Saul (point to King Saul) would get mad, David would play music on his harp to make King Saul feel better.***

***Can you wiggle your fingers like you are playing the harp, too?***

(Kids can wiggle fingers)

***David was a good friend to King Saul.***



***King Saul had a son named Jonathan. David and Jonathan were best friends.***

***They were kind to each other and shared with each other every day.***

***Show me a big smile, like David and Jonathan.***

***(Kids will smile big)***

***David and Jonathan were good friends.***



***One day, King Saul got very mad at David.***

***Because Jonathan was a good friend, he helped David hide from the king.  
Jonathan talked to his dad, and King Saul stopped being mean to David.***

***Let's all clap for Jonathan!*** (Kids will clap)

***God wants you and me to be a good friend to others, just like David and Jonathan!***

***Let me hear you say this after me:***

(Pause to allow kids to repeat each line.)

***I Will Be*** (thumbs to chest)

***A Good*** (two thumbs up)

***Friend!*** (give high five)
